## Dear Members:

This letter is to clarify any misunderstanding you may have of when, and at what date, you were being represented by IBEW Local 702. On or about March 8, 2001, there was a conversation between myself and J. T. Hill of Alcoa. At that point Mr. Hill informed me that Local 702 would continue to represent the employees at the Warrick Power Plant.
